I was with the company at Jacksonville Fla. I remember the command marching from Jacksonville to Baldwin Fla a distance of about 15 miles I was on this march.

I remember he complained of being lame on that march. I can not remember that he hurt his ankle on that march. I can not say whether this was before or after I first knew of his complaining of his ankle while drilling. I can not tell you whether we were at Jacksonville Fla or at Benedict Va first.

I was at Deep Bottom Va in the fight, the date I can not give, but it was after we left Florida. I do not remember that this claimant was injured in any manner during this fight.

I was detached away from my company just after the Deep Bottom fight, and was a teamster. I went to Texas with my command but was not on that.
