

in our hospital. We came from Jacksonville Fla camp to the fight at Deep Bottom Va. I do not remember if this soldier was present at the battle of Deep Bottom Va. The last time I remember to have seen him was at Petersburg Va about four months before my discharge. After he received his injury he was not fit for duty much of the time, and if I am not mistaken was in some hospital at the time of the battle of Deep Bottom. I do not know what hospital and can not be sure if he was there in any hospital. If he was in hospital I do not remember it. I was in the battle of Deep Bottom but was wounded there myself and can not tell you if he was injured there, or even if he was there. I do not remember after we were at Petersburg Va.

Q Are you certain that he had a sprained ankle as you have described?

A Yes sir I am certain about the place and circumstances under which I knew of his ankle being injured, but I can not be certain as to the date, and I did not know of his being injured at any other time or place.

Q You have heard soldiers different statements as to time and place and circumstances under which he received his injury can you offer any explanation as to discrepancies?

A I can not for I have told you all that
