DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 16th day of May, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and eight, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, James Wilson, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 61 years of age, and a resident of county of Calvert, State of Maryland; and that he is the James Wilson, on the 21st day of October, 1863, as a Private, in Company 8th H. Seventh Regiment of U S Cold Light (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.) in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Indian Creek Texas (State name of war, Civil or Mexican.) on the 19th day of October, 1866. That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. 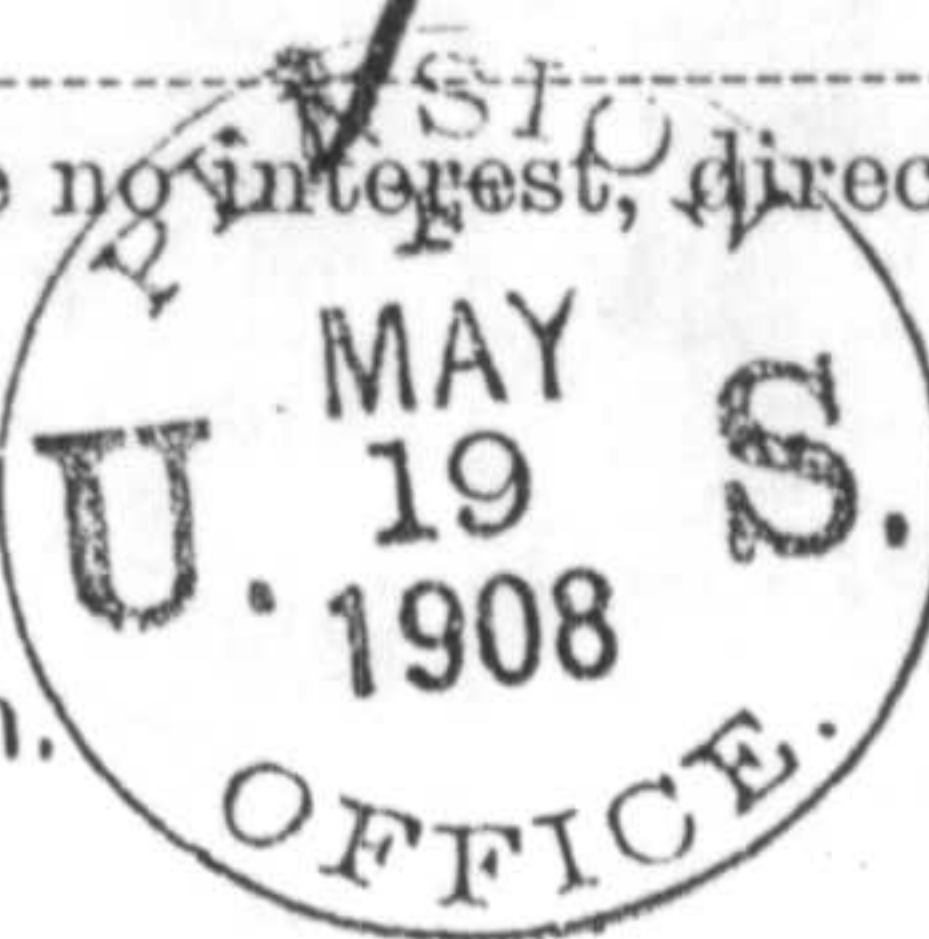
