

GENERAL AFFIDAVIT.

 as follows:

David Brooks states that he knew James Wilson
before he was of marriageable age, that he knows he first married
Sarah Curtis who died, he afterwards married this applicant
Annie E. Wilson who resided in Baltimore City, I did not
know her until after her marriage to James Wilson, I know
she was his wife until he died Dec 5th 1918, and were now
divorced.

Hezekiah Locks states that his evidence is the same as
this above of David Brooks he lived near James Wilson
and his wife Annie E. Wilson.

+ saw them very frequently.

Hezekiah Locks also lived near James Wilson and Annie
E. Wilson his wife, and saw them frequently.
