

Declaration for Increase of an Invalid Pension.

(GENERAL LAW.)

State of Maryland, County of Calvert, ss:

On this 2nd day of January, A. D., one thousand nine hundred and six personally appeared before me a Justice of The Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid James Wilson, aged 57 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States by certificate number 490607, and duly enrolled at the Washington Pension Agency, at the rate of six dollars per month, by reason of disability from Lumbago and injury to right foot

That he was not in the U. S. Military or Naval service before October 1863 or after November 1866.
