

ACT OF APRIL 19, 1908.

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

AS AMENDED BY THE ACT OF SEPT. 8, 1916.

To be executed before a Court of Record or some officer thereof having custody of its seal, a Notary Public, or Justice of the Peace, whose official signature shall be verified by his official seal, and in case he has none, his signature and official character shall be certified by a Clerk of a Court of Record, or a City or County Clerk.

On this 14th day of December, A. D. one thousand nine hundred andEighteen personally appeared before me, a NOTARY PUBLIC, within and for theCounty and State aforesaid, Caroline Kell aged 77 years, aresident of BALTIMORE City County of BALTIMORE State of MARYLAND

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is the widow of

Bazil Kell (Name of Soldier) who enlisted under the name ofBazil Kell (Name under which soldier enlisted.) on the 21st day of October, A. D.1863, as a Private in Company G in the Seventh Regiment ofU. S. Volunteer Infantry (Name of State, and whether Infantry, Cavalry, Artillery or name of vessel if in Navy.) and served at least ninety days in the late Warof the Rebellion, in the service of the United States, who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED April 13th1866, and died May 24th 1897 That he was not employed in

(Date of death; cause need not be stated.) the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above.

(Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to

that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.)

That he was never employed in the military or naval service of the United States after the

day of April 1866 That she was married under the name ofCaroline Parker (Date of soldier's last discharge.) to said Bazil Kellthe 5th or 18th day of 1879 A. D. I., byat BALTIMORE MARYLAND there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that she had not

been previously married; that her said husband had not been previously married. (4)

That she has not remarried since the death of the said Bazil Kell

(Name of soldier or sailor.)

That the names and dates of birth of all the children of the soldier, now living, and under sixteen years of

age, are as follows:

That she has not abandoned the support of any one of her children, but that they are still under her care or

maintenance. That a prior application for pension has been filed by herself or the soldier.Certificate (A or no.) 493.531

That she makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States,

under the provisions of the act of April 19, 1908. She hereby appoints, with full power of

substitution and revocation, AS AMENDED BY THE ACT OF SEPT. 8, 1916.

her true and lawful attorney to prosecute her claim, the fee to be TEN DOLLARS, payable as prescribed by law.
