30 Said parties lived together continuously, as man & wife
 31 all during said period. The said John W. Owens
 32 died about five years ago. Yes Sir, I attended his funeral.
 33 No Sir, the said Claimant has not remarried or lived
 34 with any man as wife since the death of the said
 35 John W. Owens. No Sir, as a matter of fact, I don't know
 36 of any one personal knowledge whether or not the said
 37 John W. Owens or this Claimant had ever been
 38 married prior to their marriage to each other or not.
 39 I can only say, that I have heard that either had been
 40 previously married. The said Claimant has always been
 41 a woman of good moral character ever since I have
 42 known her. Yes Sir, I testified in this claim before. I
 43 testified twice before and each time before Notary Public
 44 Barry of Port Deposit, this County. [See B. 8 & 9]
 45 After having read my prior affidavits in this claim,
 46 I have to say: I did not state at any time that I knew
 47 this Claimant and the said John W. Owens from the
 48 time that they were of marriageable age, that they were
 49 ever married before their marriage to each other and
 50 that they were married in the fall of 1867. I know nothing
 51 more about their marital relations than I have stated
 52 before you. Yes Sir, I have seen that said parties were
 53 living together as man and wife when I first moved over
 54 here in January, 1867, and they so continued to live
 55 together to his death. This deposition has been
 56 read to me, I have understood the questions asked and
 57 my answers thereto are correctly recorded herein.
