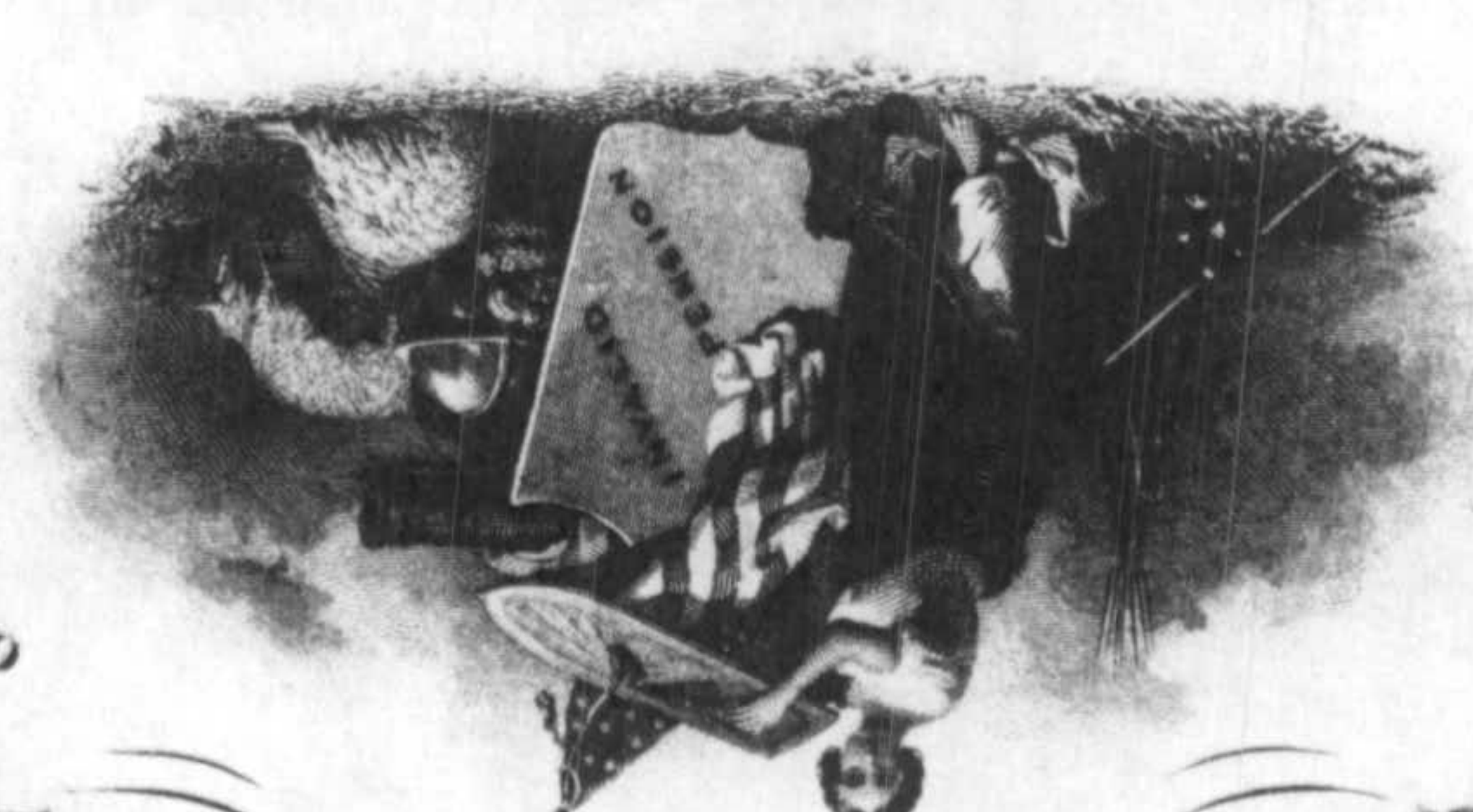
Given at the Department of the Interior this
