Ft Monroe, Va Aug 1/64 with G.C. flesh wound left thigh, middle third, and was transferred Aug 15/64. Entered Summit House G.H. West Philadelphia, Pa. Aug 17/64 with G.C. wound middle third left thigh, was furloughed Oct 14, returned Nov 1/64, and returned to duty Feb 8/65.*
