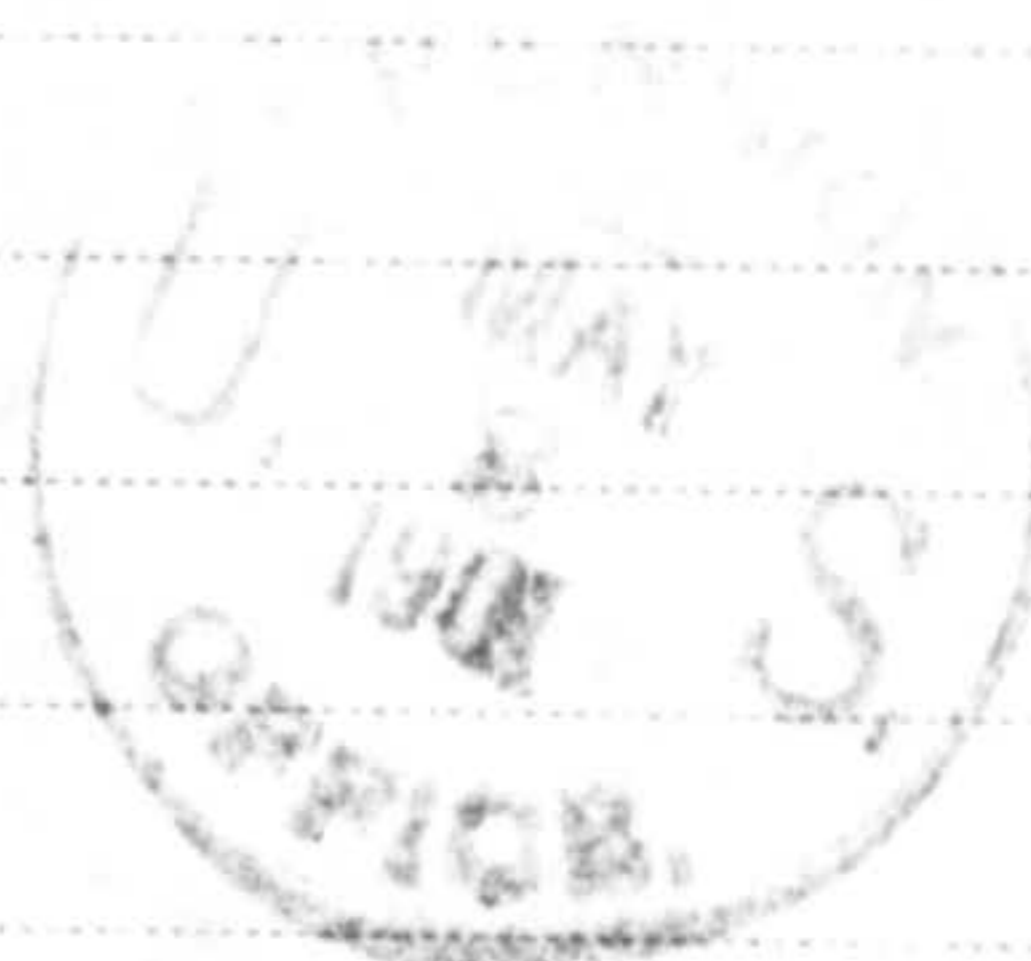

On this day and date below written, personally appeared the affiant whose signature is hereto affixed and who being duly sworn according to law testified as follows:

"My name is *James Benson* . I am *54* years old, and

I reside in Baltimore, Md. at No. *329 Sanson Alley* Street.

I have known *Henrietta Frisby* the Claimant and the Soldier *Benjamin Frisby* for twenty five years. She came to Baltimore from the Custom House of Md and never married when I first knew them. During all my acquaintance with them they recognized each other as husband and wife, and were never divorced or separated but lived together continuously up to the day of his death. Claimant has not remarried since the death of her husband the Soldier. The Soldier's life was not insured for Claimant's benefit. Claimant is possessed of no property or income whatsoever, but has been and still is a very poor woman indeed, entirely dependent upon her own daily labor for support, there being no one legally bound to support her since the death of her husband the Soldier.
