DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

Note.—This can be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. If such officer uses a seal, certificate of clerk of court is not necessary, If no seal is used, then such certificate must be attached.

STATE OF MARYLAND, CITY OF BALTIMORE, ss :

On this 10 day of Jan, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety, personally appeared before me, a JUSTICE OF THE PEACE, within and for the City and State aforesaid John W Smith, aged 52 years, a resident of the City of BALTIMORE, State of MARYLAND, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

John W Smith, who was ENROLLED on day of Dec 63, 1863, in Co E 19 USCT & was transferred to US Navy on the "Petomsky" & "Princeton" in the service of the

United States in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Phila Pa, on the day of August, 1865

That he is wholly unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of Vertigo Neurosalgia rheumatism heart disease & debility (Here name the disease or injuries from which disabled.)

I was disabled at the date of filing his first application in 1890 & he asks re issue of his ~~application~~ certificate to change date of commencement & also an increase of consideration of his claim under act of March 6, 1896

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief of a permanent character. That he has applied for pension under application No. That he is a pensioner under Certificate No. 25-668 (If a pensioner, the Certificate number only need be given.)

If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.) That he has never been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States, under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints

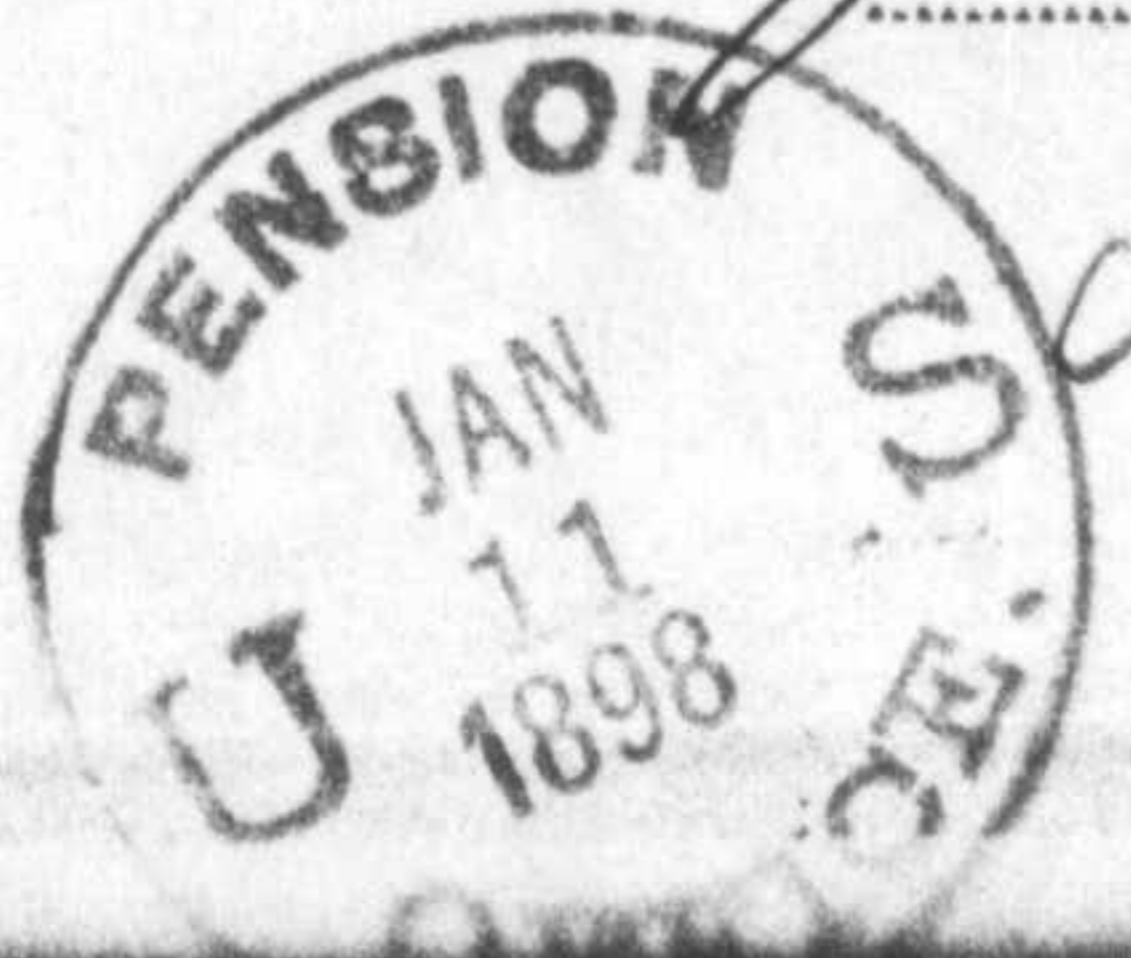
