Declaration for an Original Invalid Pension.

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

John Smith who was ENROLLED as a priv on the 18th day of

Dec, 1863, in Company E of the 19th regiment of USCS

commanded by Capt Lewis and was honorably DISCHARGED at

Philadelphia Pa on the 19th day of August, 1865; That his

personal description is as follows: Age 44 years; height 5 feet 4 inches; complexion dark

hair black; eyes black. That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the

service and in the line of duty at Benedict in the State of Maryland

on or about the 19th day of August, 1863, he took deep

Cold and Misery in Head (Here state the name or nature of disease, or the location

of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its cause; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.)

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: at Kings Hill Hosp

from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of

the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid
