Declaration for Pension

Under the Act of February 6, 1907

City,
State of Maryland, -----, County of Baltimore, -----, SS:

On this 20 day of February A. D. one thousand nine hundred and
Seven, personally appeared before me Charles Nevil

a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid
John W. Smith, ----- a resident of the ----- City, -----

State of Maryland, ----- who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is
the identical John W. Smith, ----- who was ENROLLED on the 18th
day of December 1863, in Co. "E", 19th Regt., U. S. C. T. Inf.
(Here state rank in company and regiment in Military service, or vessel, if in Navy.)

Transferred to U. S. Navy. ----- in the service of the
United States in the Civil War, and served at least 90 days, and was HONOR-
(Civil or Mexican) (90 days if Civil War; 60 days if Mexican)

ABLY DISCHARGED at Philadelphia, Pa., on the 19th day of August, 1865

That he has ----- been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated
above Co. "G", 10th Regt., U. S. Cavalry. Enlisted 1875;
(Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above and the dates at which it began and ended.)

Discharged 1880; at Fort Sill, Indian Ter.

That he is 66 years of age, having been born on the 15th day of March 18 40,
and asks for a pension of \$ 12 per month [62 years of age, \$12; 70 years, \$15; 75 years or over, \$20].

is a pensioner under Certificate No. 25,668, ----- Pensioned at \$ 8 per month.

under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.

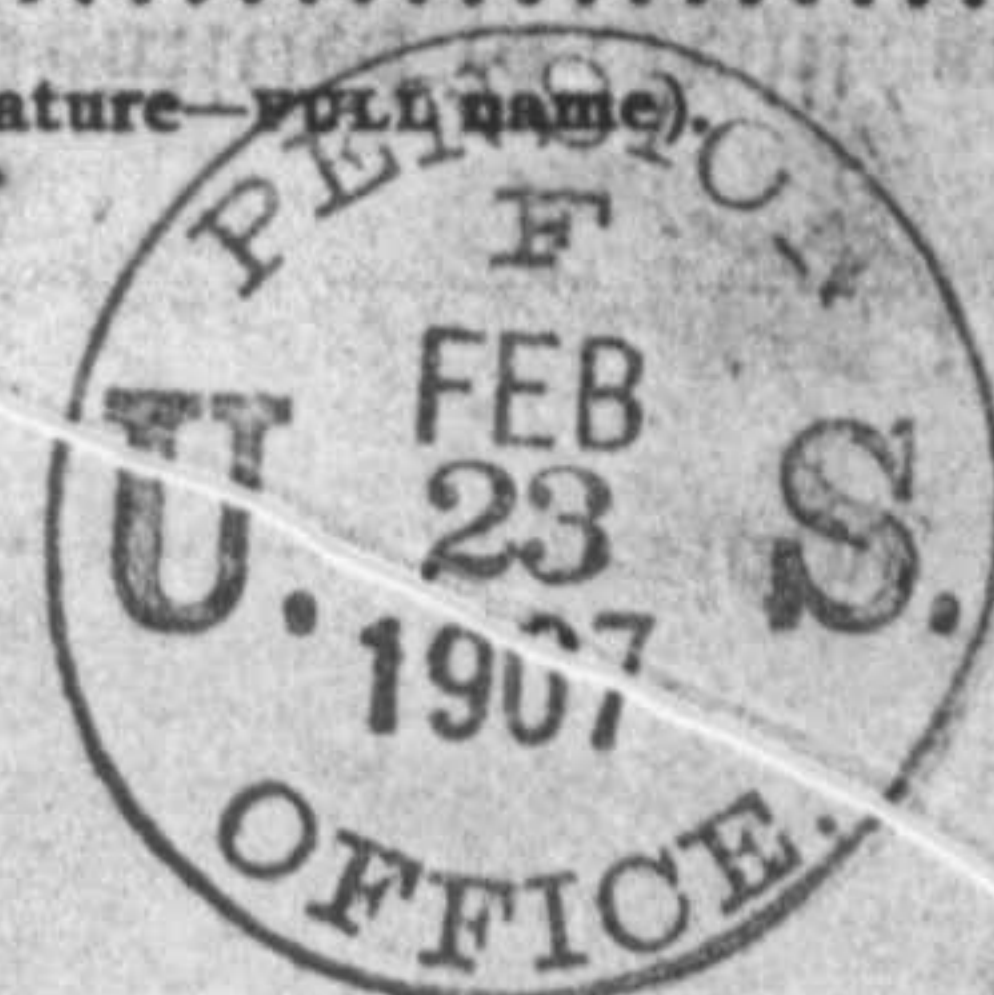
