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Have seen claimant on an average at least once a month since he came to Baltimore City, and know that early time I saw him he had the same cough and was short breasted.

Dont know that claimant had rheumatism, but do know that he was crippled up when he came home in 1866, and has been ever since, he walks, sterr, stiff, and at times he uses a cane.

Know that while Dr. Dix was attending claimant immediately after discharge my sister now Mrs. Louisa Waters who, lives 3 miles from Ellicott City Howard Co, Md. on the Columbia Pike, nursed him. Her Husbands name is Frank Waters.

Am not related to claimant, or interested in the claim for pension.
