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Know this as I was often, almost daily, at his mother's house, also saw him often while at Mr. Powell's. Saw Clint with his right knee swelled up and bandaged, and his leg resting in a chair. Know that he walked lame from as I understood it rheumatism up to the time I left Accusmac. Mr. James Hickman, storekeeper 3 miles from Drummondtown. Mr. Thos. Powell (whose address can be obtained from Mr. Geo. Powell of Onancock) can tell you more as to claimant's condition than I.

Claimant suffered with cough and rheumatism before he had the sickness before mentioned.

Am not related to claimant or interested in this claim for pension.
