and was discharged at *Indianola Texas*, *Oct. 13*, 186*6*

While serving in Co. *H*, *7* Reg't *U.S.C.T.* he was disabled by *pleurisy, pneumonia, and rheumatism* and *sequela at Benedict Md. Nov. 1864.*

also *hemorrhage at Jacksonville Fla. in 1864*

and was treated in hospitals of which the names, location, and dates of treatment are as follows:
