particular Complaint was but I know he could not perform military
duties & that since his discharge his Complaint has been Scurvy &
Rheumatism & I can only say he has never been a well man since
his discharge he can get about & has a day or two in which he
seems better than usual but has never been a well man & one
able to do Manual Labor I have on an average ^{seen him} once a week (I have
seen him three times & more a week for periods, then I was absent
from the City - about the year 1884 during this time of course I did not
see him I was away preaching) The claimant certainly imbibed
his indisposition & diseases in the army & from his exposure there
His habits were good always both in the army & since his discharge
