On the 18th day of October 1871 Personally
appeared before me Clerk of the Superior Court
a Court of record within and for the County & State of
Joseph Baisac, aged 34 years, a resident of the City
of Baltimore in the State of Maryland, who being
duly sworn according to Law, declares that he is the
identical Joseph Baisac who enlisted in the service
of the United States at Benedict in the State of
Maryland, on or about day of in the year
as a Private in Co I, commanded by
Capt Charles D. Trefle, in the 7th Regiment
U.S. C, I commanded by Col James Shaw
in the war of 1861, and was Honourably discharged
at Camp at Federal Hill City of Baltimore
in the State of Maryland on or about the
day of in the year. and that while
in the service of the said, and in the line of duty

He received a gun shot wound
carrying away the 1st joint of the index finger
of right hand - also gun shot wound
on left side of the Head, fracturing the
skull - which occasionally produced
Vertigo & Dizziness and Blindness

He also swears that he
does not know where to find any
Commissioned Officer of his company
