or about the ^{1st} day of August, 1864, while
in the line of duty, and without fault
or improper conduct on his part, in action
at Deep Bottom, State of Virginia, said
soldier received gun-shot wound of right leg above
the knee. Affiant makes the above state-
-ment from personal knowledge having
been present at the time and place
above named, and an eye-witness.

Affiant further declares that he was
discharged at the same date and
place, viz; Oct. 13th, 1866, at Indian-
ola, State of Texas - with the claimant
who was a sufferer from his aforesaid
disability at the date of his discharge
