

Claimant's Affidavit.

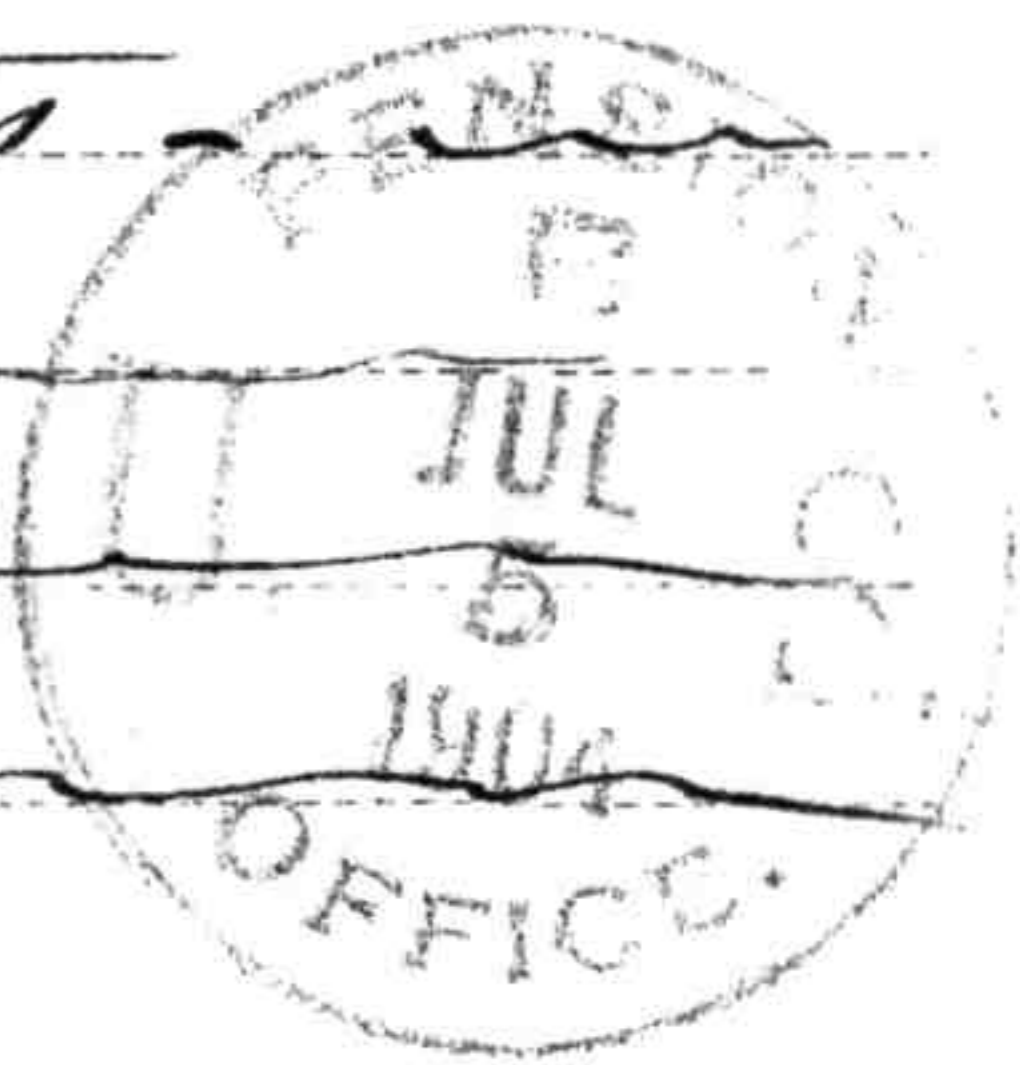
State of Maryland, County of Kent ss:

whose residence and Post Office address is Chestertown, Maryland, believed by me to be reputable and entitled to credit, and who being duly sworn, declares in relation to

aforesaid case as follows: That she was acquainted with John W.

Anderson the soldier before he ever married. His first wife was named Harriet Blake and who died according to a record kept by her husband the soldier on the 26th day August 1870. His second wife was named Emma Wraight and she died according to the record kept by her husband, the soldier, on the 6th day of April 1876. which record is in my possession, and affiant is the third wife of said soldier and she was never married until she married the said soldier. As to her former husband's (the soldier) former two marriages, she has a clear recollection, but as to the dates of their death she gets from the record made by her husband. She recollects the facts of their death but not the dates.
