

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

ACT OF JUNE, 27, 1890.

To be executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having custody of its Seal, or a Notary Public, or a Justice of the Peace, whose Official Signature shall be verified by his own Official Seal, if he has one, or by the proper Clerk, under Seal.

State of Maryland, County of Kent, ss:

On this 31st day of July, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety

personally appeared before me, a Clerk of the Circuit Court for Kent County, within and for the county and State aforesaid John W. Anderson

aged 44 years, a resident of the Front St. Chestertown, county of Kent, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law,

declares that he is the identical John W. Anderson who was enrolled on the

16th day of January, 1864, in Co F 7th Regt. U.S.C. Here state rank, company, and regiment in military service, or

as Private at Camp Stanton, Benedict, Md. vessel, if in the Navy.

in the service of the United States in the War of the Rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was

honorably discharged at Indianola, Texas, on the 13th

day of October, 1866. That he is now unable to earn a support

by manual labor by reason of Rheumatism, Injury to Back and Spine Here name the diseases or injuries from which disabled.

contracted at Russell's Mills, Va on 16th Aug. 1864.

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief per-

manent; that he has never applied for pension under application No. ; that he is a

pensioner under Certificate No. If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given; if not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Geo. W. Garrison 108 St. Paul St. of Baltimore

State of Maryland, his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, and to receive

therefor a fee of ten dollars; that his post-office address is Front St. Chestertown
