

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

To be executed before a Court of Record or some officer thereof having custody of its seal, a Notary Public or Justice of the Peace whose official signature shall be verified by his official seal, and in case he has none, his signature and official character shall be certified by a Clerk of a Court of Record, or a City or County Clerk.

On this 30th day of Aug, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-

personally appeared before me, The Clerk of the Circuit Court within and for the County and State aforesaid,

Wesley Broadway, aged 44 years, a resident of the town of Chestertown, County of Kent, State of Maryland,

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

Wesley Broadway, who was ENROLLED on the 23rd day of Sept, 1863, as private in Co. A. 7th Regt. U.S.C.T. in the service of the United States

in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at

Indianola Texas, on the 13th day of Oct, 1866. That he

is partially unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of "Rheumatism" "Dyspepsia" "gunshot wound of thigh of right leg, and resulting rheumatism (all which incurred in Union service)"

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That he has heretofore applied for pension under application No. 655,231. That he is a pensioner under Certificate No.

(If a pensioner, the Certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States, under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, O. H. BUDLONG, of WASHINGTON, D. C. State of

his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, the fee to be TEN DOLLARS as prescribed by law. That his POST-OFFICE ADDRESS is Chestertown, County of

Kent, State of Maryland.
