

DECLARATION FOR ORIGINAL INVALID PENSION.

TO BE EXAMINED BEFORE A COURT OF RECORD OR SOME OFFICER THEREOF HAVING IN HIS POSSESSION AND UNDER THE STUDY OF ITS SEAL.

On this 10th day of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, personally appeared before me, DuChesne of the Circuit Court, a court of record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Wesley Broadway, aged 43 years, a resident of the Chestertown, county of Kent, State of Md.

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Wesley Broadway who was ENROLLED on the 23rd day of Sept 1863, in Company W of the 7th Regiment of U.S.C. commanded by Capt. Chas. G. Rice and was honorably DISCHARGED at Indianola Texas on the 13th day of Oct 1866; that his personal description is as follows: Age, 43 years; height about 6 feet; complexion, black; hair, black; eyes, black

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty near Jacksonville, in the State of Florida on or about the day of March 1864, he contracted dyspepsia caused by unwholesome food, bad water

and aggravated by the hardships & exposure of the service. That also about Aug. 16, 1864 at Deep Bottom Va. received gunshot wound of right thigh, which resulted in chronic rheumatism, from which he has suffered since discharge to present time

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: not treated in hospitals but by a surgeon Joel Morse (who was killed at Brownsville, Texas, May 27, 1866, by Mexicans) for dyspepsia.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the Town of Chestertown Kent Co. in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been that of a man servant & laborer,

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a farmer That he is now disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim. That he has never received nor applied for a Pension. That his POST OFFICE ADDRESS is Chestertown county of Kent State of Maryland.
