For Rheumatism, by Dr. W. J. Urie, Thos. H. Whalands and Jas. A. Perkins, as above stated. That, from his discharge to the present time, he has been prevented from following his usual occupation, to extent of his proportion of one-half labor, to full labor of a sound, able-bodied man, incapacitated by reason of his afore-said disabilities.
