SIR:

In reply to your request I have to state that I was a member of the same Reg. (7th U.S.C.V.) and co. "E", enrolled under name of James Thomas. I was with my comrade Broadway at or near Jacksonville, Fla. and Fort Harrison Va. and other places. (I cannot now recollect date) and at above last named place I observed he was sick from stomach trouble as he told me and I observed that he bleated considerably and badly and expectorated especially after eating. I had met him while at the Surgeon's Tent procuring medicine for his ailment. as I was on the same ward. I have seen him almost daily since the war and have worked with him and have observed that he has been and still is afflicted as above stated, and I would not consider him more than one-half man.
