

GENERAL AFFIDAVIT.

That affiants have personally and intimately known the claimant for 25 years and 25 years respectively, and that the claimant was, on Feb'y, 1898, and from that time to present, has been, and at present time, is afflicted with a support from stomach trouble which aforesaid disability is not the result of vicious habits and they believe, is of a permanent character.

Affiants personally know of above facts from
 having an intimate acquaintance and
 social intercourse with the claimant, seen
 him face to face daily, having seen him fre-
 quently complain and seen him while
 laboring from the excruciating, confined
 to his house, and from general knowledge

In affiant's opinion the claimant has been and is incapacitated for performing manual labor (hard work) for extent of one-half labor proportionately of a sound able-bodied man, during the aforesaid last period, and at present, by reason of his aforesaid disability.
