I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt from your Office of application for Pension No. 114,169, and to return it herewith, with such information as is furnished by the files of this Office.

It appears from the Rolls on file in this Office, that "Jacob H. Hazard" was enrolled on the 1st day of January, 1864, at Heret Md in Co. "F", 19th Regiment of W. S. L. Troops Volunteers, to serve Three years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a Corporal on the 8th day of January 1864, at Camp Stanton, in Co. "F", 19th Regiment of W. S. L. Troops Volunteers, to serve Three years, or during the war. On the Muster Roll of Co. "F" of that Regiment, for the months of November and December 1864, he is reported "Died at W. R. R. Mansion Hospital November 3rd 1864 of Chronic Dysentery"
