DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

NOTICE.—This application may be sworn to before a JUSTICE OF THE PEACE, NOTARY PUBLIC, or before a Clerk of Court.—If the Justice or Notary has no seal, the Clerk of the County Court must add his certificate of official character hereon, and NOT ON A SEPARATE SLIP OF PAPER.

On this 29 day of Sept, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety- , personally appeared before me, Justice of the Peace

of the court, the same being a COURT OF RECORD within and for the county and State aforesaid Sarah Martin, aged 34 years, a resident of the city of Balto, county of Md.

State of Md., who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is the widow of Richard Martin, who enlisted under the name of Richard Martin at East New Market, Md, on the day of A. D. 18, in Co. 30th U.S. Cald. Troops, 7th Regt.

and served at least ninety days in the late War of the Rebellion, who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED Balto. Md. 15 April 64, and died 1881. June 27 of Brights disease of Kidneys (The cause of death need not be stated.)

That she was married under the name of Sarah Stanley, to said Richard Martin, on the 30 day of June 1873, by Rev. Mr. Thomas, (Cald.) at Balto. Md. there being no legal barrier to said marriage. (If there was a former marriage of claimant or her husband, state it here and how dissolved.)

That she has not remarried since the death of the said (Name of soldier or sailor.)

That she is without other means of support than her daily labor. That names and dates of birth of all the children now living under sixteen years of age of the soldier are as follows:
