DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That he is a pensioner under certificate No. 185290. That he has applied for pension under original No.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of May 11, 1912.

That his post-office address is Chestertown Md, county of Kent State of Maryland
