

DECLARATION FOR ADDITIONAL INVALID PENSION

On this 15th day of August, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace

John H. Gould within and for the County and State aforesaid, aged 50 years, a resident of Chester town, County of Kent, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a

pensioner of the United States under the Act of Congress approved June 27, 1890, by Certificate number 185-290, and duly enrolled at the Washington D.C. Pension Agency, at the rate of eight (8) dollars per month, having served in the military service of the United States Co. H 30 U.S.C.T.

that his present physical condition is such that he believes himself entitled to receive an increased rate for his pensioned disabilities, shell wound of back and general debility

Application is also hereby made for additional pension by reason of the following-named new disabilities for which he is not pensioned affecting of head, breast and side, and disease of digestive organs.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, **GEORGE E. LEMON,**

of WASHINGTON, D. C., his true and lawful Attorney, to prosecute his claim; and in consideration of services done and to be done in the premises, he hereby agrees to allow his said Attorney, George E. Lemon, a fee of ten dollars, payable only in the event of the allowance of the claim by the Commissioner of Pensions.
