Sir:-

I have the honor, herewith, to submit the following report, with return of papers, in the above designated claim. Said claim was returned to the district for an additional statement from the claimant.

The said claimant now admits that she came to Chestertown, Md; as the wife of one John Giles, but she insists that she was never married to him and she positively declares that she never heard from or of him after he left her. She, likewise, states that she does not know where the said Giles was from originally, she knows of no relatives of his, nor none none of his friends or associates and, in fact, knew nothing at all about him until she "picked up with him" on the street in Washington, D.C. Her entire stock of knowledge concerning him is confined to the brief period that she lived with him.
