

103 knew the said Jones. No, John C. Bailey never had any children
104 by Jones. I don't know of any living relatives of the said
105 Jones. The said John C. Bailey married the said
106 Hester Grainger Lee in Chestertown; that is what I
107 understand. He had one child by Hester. That child's
108 name is Texas Louisiana Bailey. I understand she is
109 married now, but I don't know her husband's name or
110 where living. Yes Sir, I know of the said John C. Bailey
111 having been married twice before I married him and I knew
112 that the woman Hester was living when I married him. No
113 Sir, the said John C. Bailey and the said Hester were
114 never divorced from each other. That is, there was no
115 regular Court decree between them, but they got a bill
116 of separation from each other. Yes Sir, I have that original
117 bill of separation in my possession now. Yes Sir, you may
118 have that bill of separation for use in my claim, provided it
119 is returned to me. [Agreement of Separation between John C.
120 Bailey and Hester Bailey Lee handed to the Special Examiner
121 by the claimant; it will be found in an official envelope, appropriately
122 endorsed, with the lower papers.]
Q. 123 You have stated that you do not know where John C.
124 Bailey married Jones. Can you name any one who has
125 personal knowledge that he was regularly married to Jones.
A. 126 I don't know of a soul that knows that. John C. Bailey has
127 no living relatives except his children. I don't know of any
128 living relatives that the said Jones has. No, she left no
129 children.
Q. 130 Where was John C. Bailey living from the time he married
131 Jones to the time he enlisted in the regular army.
A. 132 He told me he lived right here in Chestertown with her eleven
