 65 don't know just when she died. All that I know about
 66 the said Jones' death is this; I remember hearing the
 67 talk at the time about Jones being dead, but when she died
 68 or when she was buried I don't know. No sir, I don't think
 69 of any particular person when I heard speak of Jones' death.
 70 You see, she went away from Chestnut with a man by the
 71 name of Reese and after that she was not known about
 72 Chestnut. I don't know just when the said Jones went
 73 away with the said Reese. I don't know whether she was
 74 regularly married to Reese or not, but after she went to
 75 living with Reese they stayed a while in Chestnut and
 76 she was called Jones Reese then. No, I never heard of any
 77 divorce between John C. Bailey & the said Jones. Well, I
 78 remember back at the time there in Chestnut about the
 79 said Jones having died and I am sure that that was before
 80 the said John C. Bailey married the claimant. Yes sir,
 81 the said John C. Bailey did marry another woman. He
 82 married Hester George. He resides some way over; at least,
 83 that is the name she went by before she married Charly George.
 84 I don't remember the date of the marriage of the said John C.
 85 Bailey to Hester George, but I know the fact of her marriage,
 86 for I made her wedding dress and I remember she was
 87 married at the home of John Jones at Chestnut. Oh!
 88 Yes sir, Charly George was dead when Hester married
 89 John C. Bailey. No sir, Jones, his wife, was not
 90 ~~married~~ [married out before signing] dead when Hester married
 91 John C. Bailey. That I do know; for the said Jones was at
 92 that time living right there in Chestnut with that man
 93 Reese. As my memory now serves me, the said Jones took
 94 up with the man Reese while John C. Bailey was away in
 95 the army. I know she and Reese were living together when
 96 John C. Bailey came back from the army that time. He
 97 had been in the army out West somewhere and was gone
 98 about five years. Yes sir, I testified in this claim before.
 99 No sir, I have no personal knowledge of the time or place
 100 of the death of the said Jones; I do remember having
 101 full at the time of her death and my best recollection
 102 is, that that was about a year before John C. Bailey married
