In your above-cited claim for pension under the Act of February 6, 1907, in which you allege that you are 62 years of age, you are advised that you stated in your declaration for increase of pension under the Act of June 27, 1890, filed May 23, 1904, that you were born in 1841 or 1842; in another declaration, filed April 24, 1906, you allege December 25, 1844, as the date of your birth, while in a declaration filed February 23, 1907, you stated that you were born in 1846.

You should explain these discrepancies under oath, and state the correct date of your birth, if known to you.
