of Pensions, on appeal to the Secretary of the Interior, or before the Committees of Congress, as may be found necessary or deemed by him best for my interests.

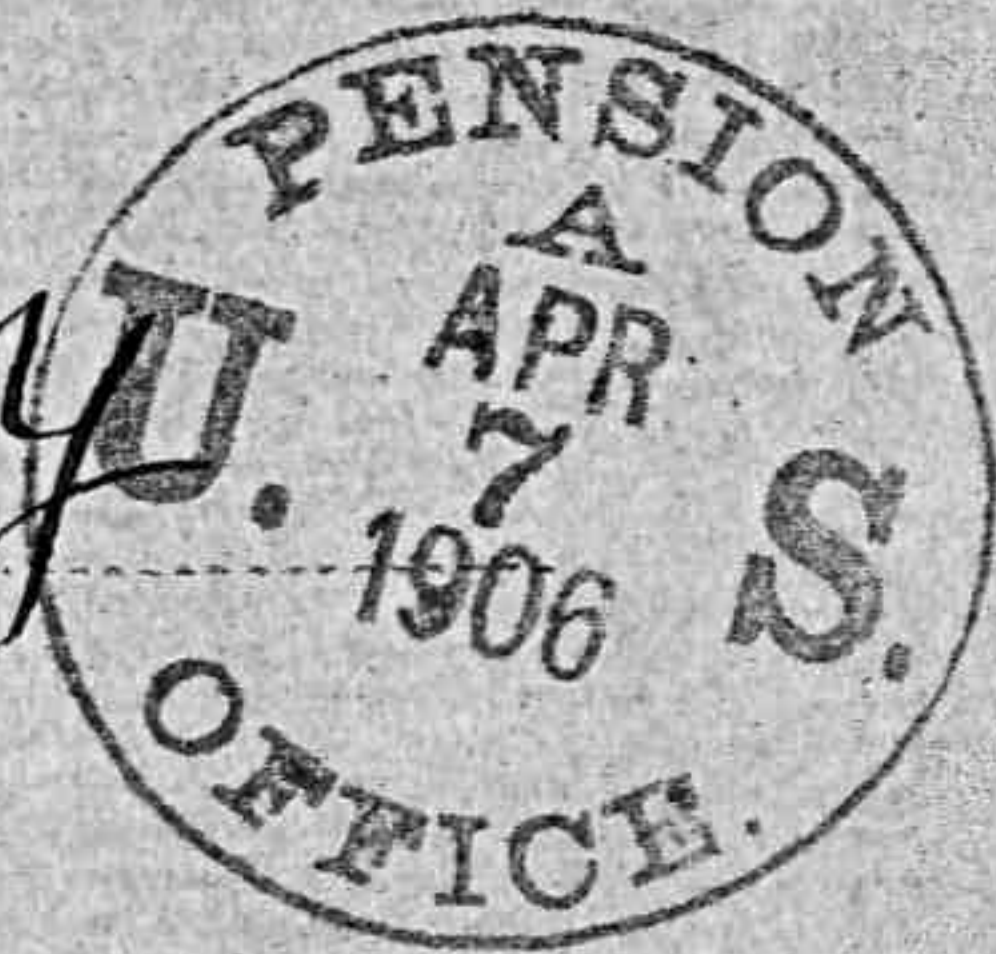
