

30 said affidavit relating to the exact name of Jone
 31 Reese and that Jone Reese was the former wife of one
 32 John C. Bailey; as I had no knowledge on these points.
 33 Mr. Fowler said that was all right, that he knew the
 34 name of the deceased was Jone and that she was the
 35 former wife of John C. Bailey, so upon Mr. Fowler's
 36 representation, I let the matter go. The records of my
 37 father that I have on his day books, but my father
 38 had another record that he kept of deaths and burials &
 39 that record I gave to Mr. J. E. Ferguson of Cheltenham, Md;
 40 who succeeded my father in business. In this connection
 41 I will state, that I understood from Mr. Fowler that he
 42 had seen that record in the possession now of Mr.
 43 Ferguson and that said record showed that the name of
 44 the deceased in question was Jone and that she died on
 45 the 13th day of November, 1889, & that was the basis of the
 46 affidavit which Mr. Fowler had me sign. The date as
 47 shown by my father's books now before me relates only to
 48 the date that the charge for the coffin etc. was made against
 49 the said Jenniah Reese. This deposition has been read to
 50 me, I have understood the questions asked & my answers
 51 are correctly recorded herein.
