

GENERAL AFFIDAVIT.

I have known Robert Riley the claimant ever since his discharge I know him to have been afflicted with Rheumatism in the shoulders and he has continued to have it ever since, year after year getting worse, he loses now about 2/3 of his time from this disability whereas up to the last year or two he lost about 1/3 of his time at manual labor I know these facts because I have lived within 200 yards of him during the time and visit him often and know his suffering
