He did not remarry until his marriage to *Olivia Brady* and with whom he lived till her death. His next marriage was to the claimant and with whom he lived till his death. They were never divorced neither has the claimant remarried since the death of her husband who died leaving no minor child or children surviving under the age of sixteen years by either marriage. The above facts are personally known to me from my long acquaintance with the late *Robert Riley* and his family. I further witness that I have no interest in the claim.
