DECLARATION FOR THE INCREASE OF AN INVALID PENSION.

ON THIS 15th day of April A. D. one thousand 906

before me, the undersigned, duly authorized to administer oaths within and for the County and State
aforesaid, personally appeared, Alexander Chaney

late a private in Company a of the Sixth Regiment of

Maryland (Col'd) Volunteers, aged 68 years, who being duly sworn according

to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, duly enrolled at the Washington D.C.

Pension Agency, at the rate of 8 dollars per month, under Pension Certificate No 683, 990

by reason of disability resulting from partial inability to earn a support by manual labor.

Rheumatism and defective Eyesight

That he was born on the 1st day of the month of March in the year 1838

That he believes himself entitled to an increase of pension for disability above stated, and hereby
makes application therefor under the Acts of June 27, 1890, and May 9, 1900

On account of an increased disability, and he thinks the rate of pension he
is now receiving is unjustly and unreasonably low and disproportionate to
the rate drawn by other pensioners for similar or equivalent disabilities.

He also claims additional pension for General debility, due to advanced

age
describe it fully and state when, where and under what circumstances the same originated.

That none of his disabilities are due to vicious habits, and that
they are to the best of his knowledge and belief of a permanent character.

That he hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation
J. W. MORRIS, of Washington, D. C., his true and lawful attorney to prosecute said claim.
