DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

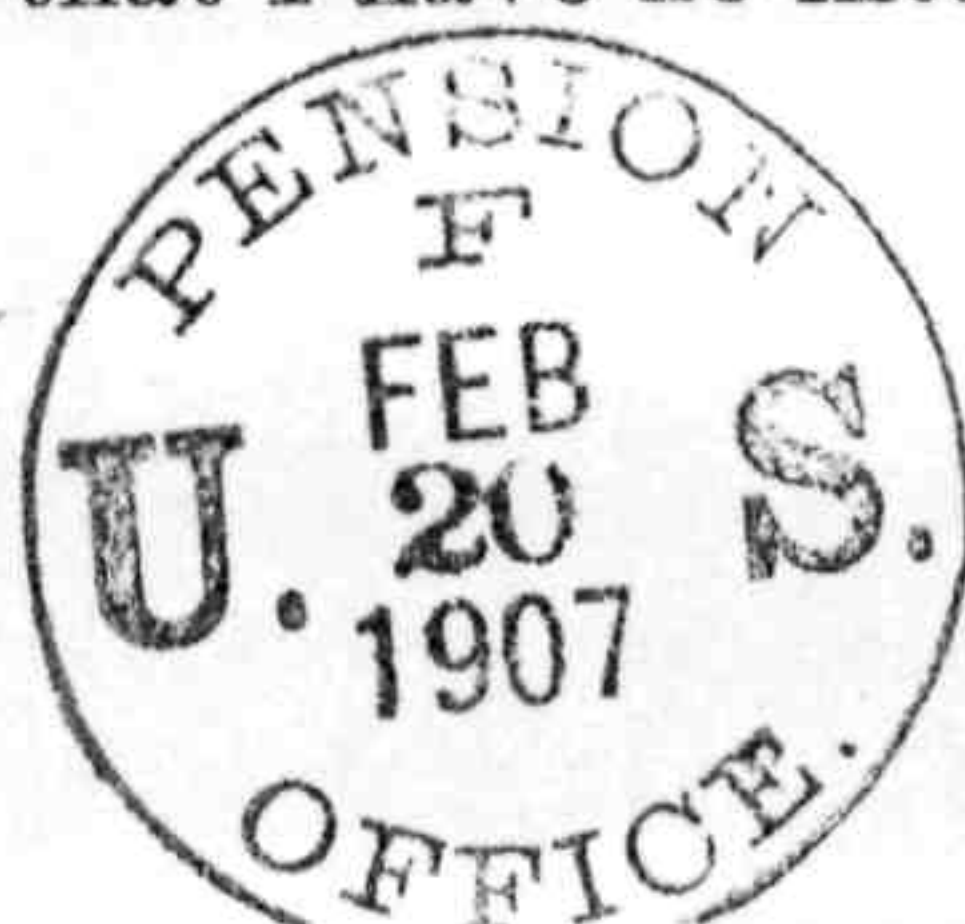
