Declaration for Pension.

prosecution of this claim.

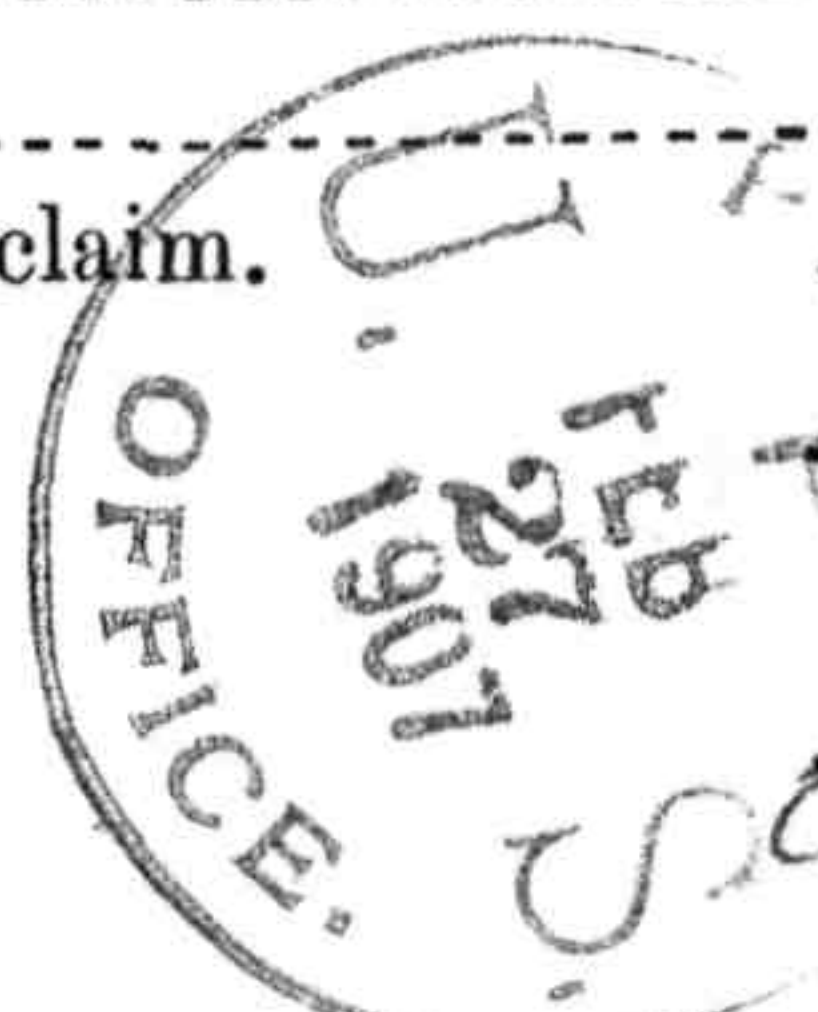
