

Powen as an Apprentice, until he shall arrive to the said age. And the said Augustus Bowen doth also on his part acknowledge himself bound, and by these presents doth contract, promise and agree to give the said Apprentice during his apprenticeship a reasonable education in reading, writing and arithmetic as far as the rule of three, and also to teach the said Cephan Child some useful trade or occupation, and to supply him with suitable clothing and maintenance during his apprenticeship; and when free, to give him the sum of thirty dollars in lieu of the customary freedom dues.
