the certificates, check, draft, or money that may be issued or paid in satisfaction of this claim,

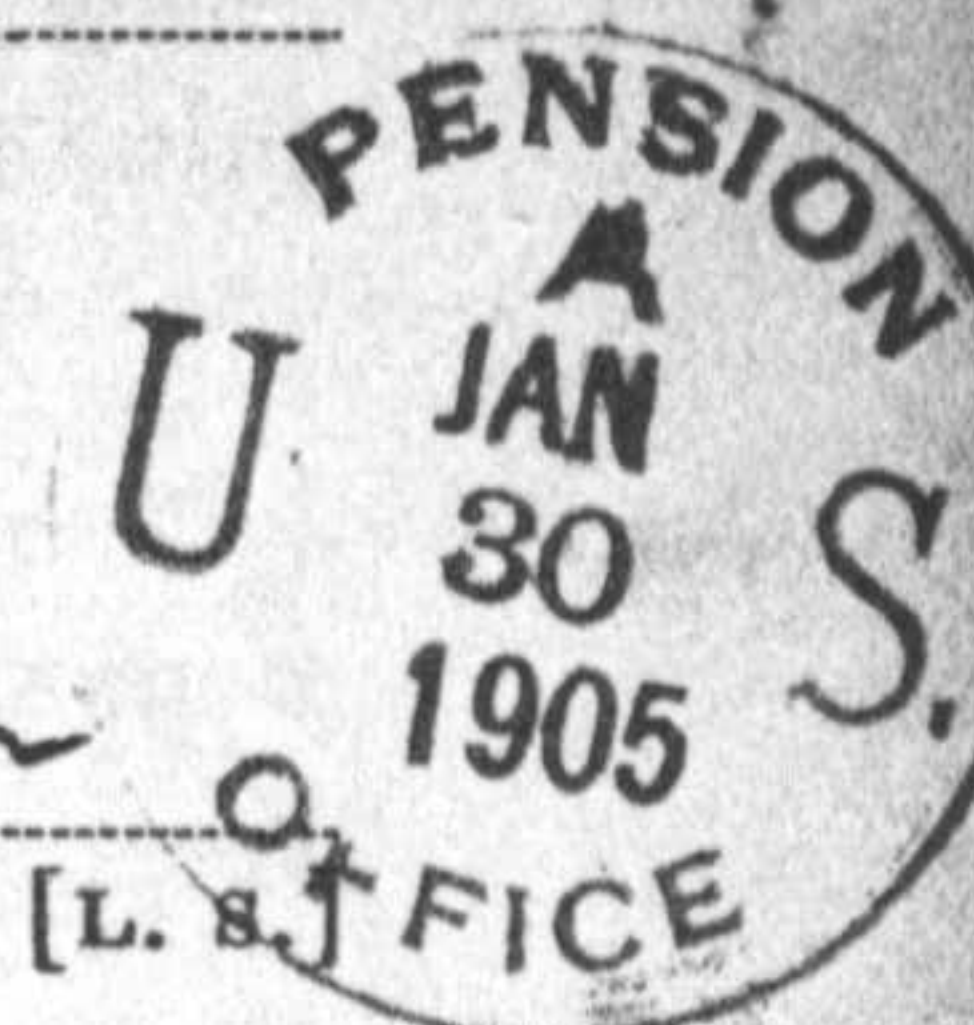
and to, from time to time, furnish any further evidence necessary, or that may be demanded,
