Sir:

In the above-cited claim for pension, there is required the claimant's statement, under oath, showing the names of all former husbands and when and how such marriages were dissolved.

The sworn statement of one witness having personal knowledge, showing whether the soldier had been married otherwise than to Anna Hawkins, prior to claimant's marriage to him, should be furnished, to be considered with the testimony of Willie A. Carter, on file.

No affidavit can be considered satisfactory that fails to state the age and post office address of the witness and how he knows the facts stated.

Do not fail to inscribe on each piece of evidence filed the soldier's name, service and number of the claim.
