name is George S Miles but I enlisted in Jan'y 19. 1864
Princess Ann, Somerset Co. Md. Co 7. 9. U.S.C. - Watkins
was the name of my mother's mother. I was free
born and was sometimes called Miles sometimes
Watkins; I became acquainted with Madison Russell
in the Army. He belonged to Co 7. 9. U.S.C. - He was
away in hospital a good part of his service
but what his troubles were I don't know
he must have had some troubles or he would not
have stayed around the hospital so much of the
time. About four or five years ago I went with
Russell to an Agents office, ^{at Paul M.} a Col. somebody who either
had one arm or one eye could remember his name.
I went there just to identify Madison Russell
as being the same man of that name who served
with me in Co 7. 9. U.S.C. I signed a paper which
was read to me and the Agent whose name
I do not know, was called in from the next
room and swore me on the Bible. I don't
know Harry S. Cummings or Robert A. Shuler.
I did not see any one else sign that paper
the Agents clerk was there. I did not know
of his despatch or the cover of it until after
he came home from the Army, and he then
stated that that was the reason he was away
from the reg't. and that what I intended making
apparent to - I am a pensioner under the name of Miles
I don't know but
