We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred in the service, viz: Gum Shot Wound of Right Hip.

Hearing is impaired much worse at times. Suffers with Rheumatism in the arms and legs. States that he draws no pension although his claim is marked as increase.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 80; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 9 inches; weight, 185 pounds; age, 46 years. General physical condition is good. Superficial scar claimed to be the result of shell wound, over the right anterior inferior process of the ilium. Scar is 1/2 inch in diameter. No evidence of injury to bone or deeper tissues. No apparent disability. Ears: Membranes are normal in appearance. Hearing: Right p-40. Left 6-40. Slight catarrhal condition of upper air passages. Rheumatism: Crepitation in the knees and shoulders with pain on motion in these joints and in hips. Heart and Lungs are normal. No other disability.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 0 rating for the disability caused by Shell Wound 6/18 for that caused by Rheumatism and Specific for that caused by nearly total deafness in one ear
