

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

ACT OF APRIL 19, 1908.—AMENDED BY ACT OF SEPTEMBER 5, 1916.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:On this 7th day of May, 1918, personally appeared before me, a JUSTICE OF THE PEACE within and for the County and State aforesaid, Jane Hensell,who, being duly sworn by me according to law, declares that she is 67 years of age and that she was born 6 Slan at Madison Hensell,That she is the widow of Madison Hensell, who enlisted November, 1863, at Co. F. 9th. U.S.C. Infantry, as a private in (Rank.)

and was honorably discharged November, 1866, having served ninety days or more during the Civil War.

That he also served

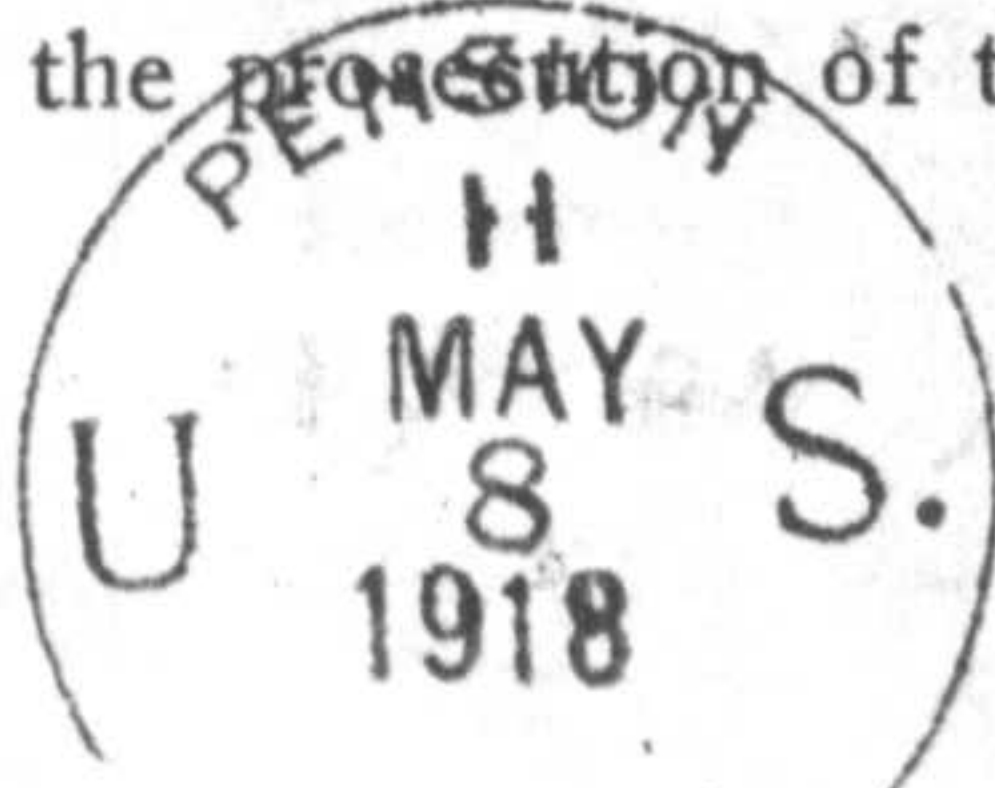
