 Private of Captain / Lieut. J. I. Ferguson
 Company, (G.) 7th Regiment of United States Colored Troops
 VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the Sixteenth day of January
 one thousand eight hundred and Sixty four to serve Three years or
 during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States,
 this Fifth day of August, 1865, at U.S. Gen. Hospital
Fort Monroe by reason of severe complications of Disability
 (*No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.*)
 Said Wm H. Butler was born in Calvert County
 in the State of Maryland, is Twenty two years of age,
Five feet Four inches high, Black complexion, Black eyes,
Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer
 Given at U.S. Gen. Hospital Fort Monr this Fifth 18th day of
August 1865.

* This sentence will be erased should there be anything
 in the conduct or physical condition of the soldier
 rendering him unfit for the Army.
