He always gives a certificate if they pay for it, and if not he gives them a little script till they pay for it. I think he made them out a certificate that night. I think I saw him sit at the table and write it off. I had seen Ballard before that, but had no acquaintance with him. I don't know what business he was in. I think he was blind before he died, but I did not notice particularly and don't pay whether he was blind then or not. I did not go to his funeral. I have never known her to marry since he died. It's been a long time since I saw her. I don't know where she lives now. I never visited her. I have only met her once since Ballard died.

Yes, I think she separated from her first husband but went together again. Whether he died I can't tell.
