

APPLICATION FOR ACCRUED PENSION.

(WIDOWS.)

; that her name before said marriage was Annie Benson; that she had not been previously married; that her husband had not been previously married; that she hereby makes application for the pension which had accrued on aforesaid certificate to the date of death; and that her residence is No. 610 Sider Alley

who, being duly sworn, say that they were present and saw Annie Ballard sign her name (make her mark) to the foregoing declaration;

that they know her to be the lawful widow of William Ballard, who died on the 23 day of February, 1892 and that their means of knowledge that said parties were husband and wife, and that the husband died on said date, are as follows:

that they have both known Annie Ballard and William Ballard living together as man and wife since Sept 1891 and that the former was present on the day he died, and the latter that he supervised his funeral
